

How to improve coordination and cross – area cooperation within the MRS?


- Communication when drafting/revising the AP and planning objectives, key actions, targets and indicators for the PAs/Has – to identify the areas of joint intervention and for avoiding duplication/owerlapping
- Cooperation when discussing/preparing/deciding new projects (one project can cover or address several policy areas), e.g.
- PAC/HAC joint support letters to the project applications submitted to the BSR Interreg Programme, or
- Joint development of a new Flagships
- Organizing joint seminars&events (PA Culture&HA Climate, PA Energy&HA Climate, PA Tourism&HA Climate)
- Involvement of the relevant PACs/HACs to the SG/MC meetings to create policy coherence and synergies
- NB! Mainstreaming does not happen in itself. Horizontal issues like Climate Change needs also coordination!



UN Agenda 2030 and SDGs



- Communication & Capitalization:
- Transfer and capitalization of good practice, examples and projects outcomes
- Initiating cross- MRS Flagships where relevant and needed (Interreg Europe as a financing instrument)
- Inviting other MRS Coordinators to the PA/HA SG/MS meetings, events
- Improved Coordination:
- Peer –learning (btw. the relevant Coordinators)
- Inviting the Coordinators to the MRS Forum
- Annual MRSs Coordinators meeting (rotating) as a part of the MRS Forum (MRSs HLG in action)
- Central coordination body (post 2020)
